RULES, REGULATIONS & WARNINGS

- All guests over 18 years of age must have completed a Waiver and Release of Liability agreement and pay appropriate fees at the registration area prior to entering the resort property. Minors must have their own parent sign the waiver form.
- All vehicles are not to exceed 10 mph while in the resort area and must yield to all pedestrians, resort guests and wildlife animals. Riders shall avoid harassing wildlife and avoid disturbing them wherever possible.
- All vehicle operators shall operate their vehicles in a safe and controlled manner and respect the rights of other guests. All riders shall report any unauthorized or illegal behavior observed.
- Operators shall obey all signs and notices and shall not trespass onto privately held lands. Travel is limited to marked trails.
- Every OHV operator over 13 years old must have a TWRA permit when trail riding on TWRA property and not deviate from properly marked, designated trails and adhere to all TWRA regulations. Copies of regulations are available in the resort registration office. **DO NOT CUT NEW TRAILS!! Riding in the WMA is a privilege to be taken seriously.**
- All operators are encouraged to wear appropriate safety equipment while riding the trails or resort roads. As a minimum, operators should wear a helmet, eye protection, long-sleeve shirt, long pants, gloves and mid-calf/snake boots. Blaze orange is required during hunting season.
- All litter will be packed out and/or disposed of properly. All trash around campsites will be placed in the proper receptacles and not littered on the resort grounds.
- **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS.**
- If you must smoke, do so with extreme caution. Field strip your butts and dispose of the filter as any other litter. **NO SMOKING INSIDE CABINS.**
- Fires are permitted only in designated areas. You are responsible for damages caused by out-of-control fires. Fireworks are not permitted.
- All pets must be kept on a leash in designated camping areas. **NO PETS INSIDE CABINS.**
- Shooting is not permitted on campground property.
- **CHILDREN UNDER 18 MUST WEAR A HELMET WHEN OPERATING OR RIDING A TRAIL BIKE OR ATV.**
- All riders will respect the rules, guests, employees, land and wildlife. Violators who flagrantly violate the rules will be subject to expulsion without refund.
- Any personal injury, property damage, or conflict with other users or persons must be reported to the management prior to leaving the resort.
- **GRAVEL DRIVES INSIDE RESORT ARE NOT TO BE USED AS A RIDING COURSE FOR CHILDREN. IT CREATES TOO MUCH DUST.**
