## GENERAL INFORMATION

***Thank you for choosing Ride Royal Blue ATV Guest Resort for your vacation.***

Please read this information page carefully.

**General Store Hours:** Our general store / reservation check in operating hours, in season, are Thursday through Saturday from 8:00 am to 2 pm and 4:30 pm to 8 pm. Sunday, in season, 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. ***Please plan to purchase riding permits during these hours.*** Off season hours or Monday through Wednesday, please call Nathan at 937/286-7658 for assistance.

**Check in – 3 PM:** Due to cleaning schedules units are seldom ready earlier than 3 PM. Please do not ask us to make exceptions and make your plans accordingly. We do not have facilities to store cold/frozen food until your check in. You may use our temporary parking area and access the trails for an early ride, if you have registered and completed all paperwork.

**Check out – 11:00 AM:** Our cleaning crews will arrive promptly at 11:00 AM. We ask that you please vacate the unit and rental site by the scheduled checkout time and keys returned to the general store so that we may ready the unit for the next guests. Failure to do so will result in another day rental by 12:00 noon. You are welcome to use the resort facilities and parking lot areas until 6:00 PM, but cabins and RV sites must be vacated by 11:00 AM.

We ask that you respect these guidelines. We must be very strict in enforcing these limits and should the actual numbers exceed the limit, you will be asked to leave without refund.

Guests that arrive late to your group, must register at the general store and complete their paperwork. Additional guests in the RV sites will be charged \$10.00 per day, per guest (children excluded). Additional tents in an RV site will be charged \$20.00 per day, per tent. The charge includes 2 guests.

**Trailer Parking:** Do not block other cabins or driveways with your trailer. There are 4 designated parking lots on the resort for trailers. Please use one that is closest to your cabin.

**Lodge/Restaurant:** Located at the top of the hill, with the big country porch. Serving breakfast each Friday, Saturday and Sunday morning from 8 AM to 10:30 AM, no reservation needed. Supper is served each Friday and Saturday, from 6:00 PM to 8:30 PM, by reservation only. You can add your name to the reservations up until 2:00 PM on Friday or Saturday by calling **937/286-7658.**

**Pets:** Strange surroundings may bring out bad behavior in pets. There are many things to consider in allowing pets into a resort. Such as noise, pet hair, fleas, ticks, and allergies to future guests. Therefore, we will only allow pets in the RV area. Pets must be kept on lease when

outside the RV. Should pets be found inside or outside of a cabin, you will be asked to leave without refund.

**Refuse:** All trash must be bagged and tied properly. Bagged trash must be set out to edge of road for pickup. We will charge a \$30.00 fee if trash needs to be removed from inside or outside of rental unit. Extended stays can pickup free trash bags at the general store. **Please respect our mountains: Do Not Litter.**

**Cell phones:** Most cell phones work around the resort and up in the mountains. A phone is available in the lodge and/or the general store for emergency use only.

**Fax & Copy Service:** We have limited copy services available and no fax service. There is a Fedex office center at the Disney Office Supply in Jacksboro, approximately 15 minutes away.

**Email & Computer Services:** There will be a WI-FI hot zone available in the RV area sometime in early spring of 2009. Our office does not provide any computers for internet or personal use.

**Firewood:** Bundles of wood can be purchased at the general store. Fires are permitted but it is your responsibility to control. Do not let fires burn unattended. Unused firewood must be removed upon checkout. Any trees, branches or debris left behind will be removed at a fee charged to your account.

**Recreation Building:** The blue rec barn is open for your enjoyment. The second floor has air hockey, a pool table, and a game table. The first floor has laundry, arcade games, TV with video games, and more. We also occasionally gather on the weekends for a free game of bingo, live bands and karaoke. Agendas will be posted on the bulletin board on the front of the barn.

**Fishing:** Our pond is stocked with over 1000 fish; such as, catfish, crappie, bass, and brim. It is catch and release. Bait and supplies can be purchased in the general store. Children must be accompanied around the pond.

**Towel exchanges:** Towels can be exchanged at the lodge from 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM and 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. You must turn in soiled for clean.

**Groceries and Fuel:** LaFollette and Jacksboro have several grocery stores, restaurants and fuel stations. Take 75 south to exit 134 and turn left. Go approximately 4 miles. **Liquor is not available in Campbell County.** Beer and wine sales sold at most grocery stores.

**Children: Parents please attend to your children.** Ride Royal Blue Resort works to maintain a family atmosphere for everyone's enjoyment. It is strongly recommended that parents obey the manufacturer's guidelines in age appropriate ATV's and trail bikes for young children. *We can not allow children to ride around the campground roads as a driving course.* This action stirs up dust, slings gravels on to parked cars and RVs, and poses a risk to property damage. Ignorance of this request will subject you to being asked to leave the resort, without refund. Please remember, *all children under the age of 18 are required to wear a helmet by the State of Tennessee.*

**Trails:** There are over 450 miles of trails in the Royal Blue/Sundquist area. Trail maps are available for purchase in the general store. **You must have a State of Tennessee riding permit if you are over 13 years of age and operate an OHV.** Permits can be purchased at the general store. Remember, do not deviate from the existing trails or cut new trails.

***Riding on paved roads:*** Please help us to keep the peace with our neighbors. It is not recommended, nor is it legal to operate an ATV on a paved road in the State of Tennessee. However, we have been told by the local authorities that guests can access the Meredith Lane trailhead via Stinking Creek Road, as long as they ride on the shoulder and in single file. Always yield to traffic and operate your OHV in a safe and slow manner.

We ask that you do not abuse this privilege. **Do not race on the roadways.** No OHV noise after 11:00 PM. The trails are open 24/7, just please **be quite** when approaching or leaving the resort.
